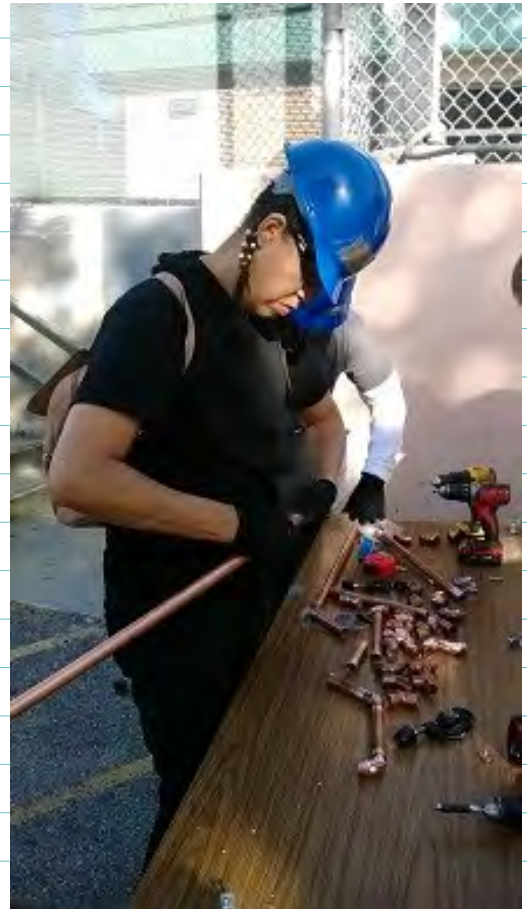

Jorge Gutierrez working on two tank active solar system (Picture on Left).

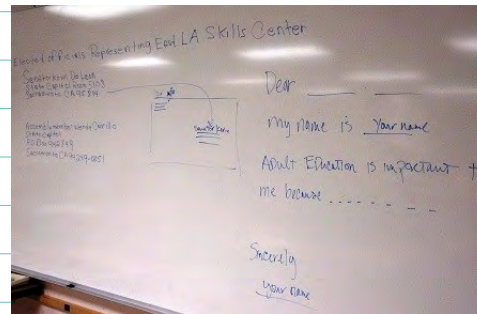
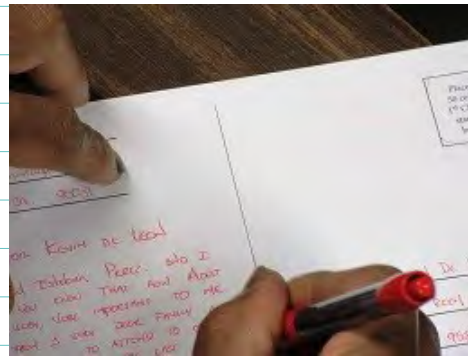
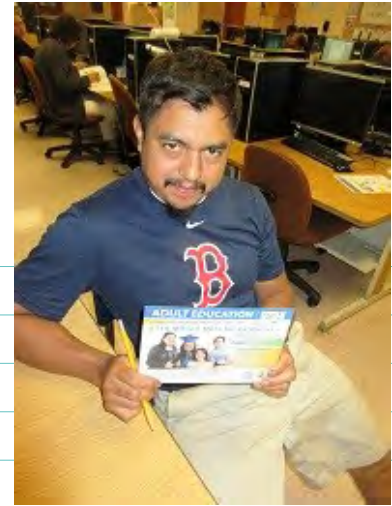
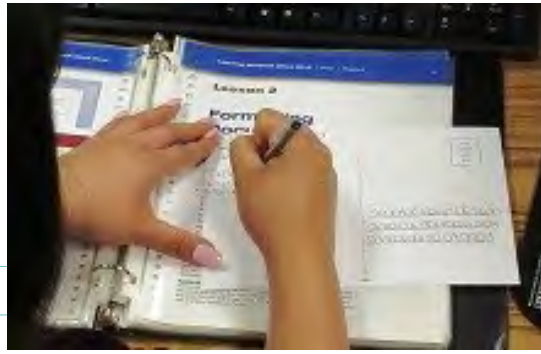
