What Cosmetologists Do:

- Keep work stations clean and sanitize tools, such as scissors and combs.
- Bleach, dye, or tint hair, using applicator or brush.
- Cut, trim and shape hair or hairpieces, based on customers' instructions, hair type and facial features, using clippers, scissors, trimmers and razors.
- Analyze client's hair and other physical features to determine and recommend beauty treatment or suggest hair styles.
- Shampoo, rinse, condition, and dry hair and scalp or hairpieces with water, liquid soap, or other solutions.

- Show Original U. S. High School Diploma, the original score sheet for the U. S. GED/HiSET or completion of the 12th grade documentation in a foreign educational system (independent NACES agency approved by LAUSD) or completion of the 10th grade. If you do not have a HS diploma, please see an advisor.
- While waiting for the next cohort to begin, students are encouraged to enroll in HIT 1: Terminology & Math 1.
