Prerequisites:

- Be at least 18 years of age
- Pass Assessment Test
 - Reading and Comprehension Level 8.0
 - Math Skill Level Equivalent to Math 7.0
- Current California Identification Card, California Driver's License, or a current US Passport.
- Current (active) California Certified Nurse Assistant License
- AHA or BLS Health Care Providers Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR)
- Be able to pass a background check and a physical exam
